

## Introducing the Foundation

I am Jill Jones-Soderman the Executive Director of the Foundation for the Child Victims of the Family Courts, to be referred to as the FCVFC.

The FCVFC is an organization that deals with Forensic evaluation, expert witness consultation toward macro case analysis, evaluation and intervention to protect vulnerable children from transfer of children from protective parents into the hands of accused abusers. The FCVFC in its mission and practice is color blind, gender neutral and acts without prejudice to race color, or creed. We deal with clients from all regions of the United States as well as dealing with international abduction, of children taken from the United States to other parts of the world, or vice versa. We also deal with issues of Standard of Care and Public Policy as it relates to institutional abuse, often as reflected in the institutional death review of children in wrongful death litigation.

We are expressly interested in the Liberty Rights of Protective parents to fend against incursions of special interest groups, whether they be men or women, whom interfere with the duty and right of a parent to protect the physical, emotional, medical, educational, religious welfare of a child/their children. Our interest is to maintain a reasonable dynamic between parents, in spite of instances of malignant Judicial discretionary interference, whether based on outright malfeasance of practice, exercise of undue influence, over reaching, conflict of interest, unconscious bias (counter transference – unconscious) or conscious bias and ignorance of areas of expertise that should be consulted.

The FCVFC routinely reviews eighteen to twenty cases per day for intake. The cases involve an extremely high conflict nature, dealing with true and false allegations that range from the most depraved insinuations of child sexual trafficking, various forms of incest, bestiality, physical brutality and neglect, to less dramatic content. No matter what the content, the consequences are no less meaningful as to ultimate impact on the subject child/children.

I am always struck by the fact that the overwhelming number of our cases are impacted most, not by the insufferable behavior of a deranged parent/custodian, but by the ignorance, indifference, insensitivity, sometimes criminally corrupt, behavior of the judiciary and their failure to act in the best interests of the child/children. Next to the police and their prosecutorial discretion have we ever found a body so negligent, so faulty in their findings as the Gate Keeper Judiciary failing to do their job, respect Due Process, and remain humble in the face of their power, as the Judiciary dealing with children and families.
