**WHEREAS** on this Court on June 4, 2001 entered an Order granting the Defendant parenting time with his three minor children, [REDACTED] every week from Friday at 5:00 p.m. until Saturday at 5:00 p.m. to be picked up by the Defendant curbside in front of Plaintiff's residence; and

**WHEREAS** the Plaintiff has failed to permit said parenting time,  
**IT IS ON THIS 27 DAY OF JUNE, 2001,**


**ORDERED** that the Defendant shall have parenting time with the three minor children from 5:00 p.m. Friday until 5:00p.m. Saturday every week, and it is further

**ORDERED** that the police shall render any and all assistance necessary to effectuate the parenting time as set forth in this Order, and it is further

**ORDERED** that failure of the Plaintiff to comply with the terms of this Order shall result in alternative custody arrangements for the three minor children, and it is further

**ORDERED** that Defendant counsel shall submit a certification for fees associated with the filing of this motion for aid of litigants rights, and it is further

**ORDERED** that a copy of this Order be served on the Plaintiff immediately by certified mail return receipt requested.
