Jill works to promote therapeutic mediation, conflict resolution and confidential, non litigated intervention in an atmosphere in which all party's rights are protected and validated. She often works as a "buffer zone" between the conflicting parties. The sanctity of the client's legal rights and confidentiality are considered critical in all disputes, including marital and custody disputes which have become a public health crisis, and exposed all involved to humiliation, financial ruin, relationship destruction and a legacy of severe emotional distress to children.
