PARENTAL ALIENATION

A Presentation of the Foundation for the Child Victims of the Courts

NYACK, NY – The Foundation for the Child Victims of the Courts, LLC will present a panel discussion focusing on “Parental Alienation, The Concept – The Myth – The Controversy” on Sunday, June 24, 2007 from 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. The session, free to the public, will take place at the Nyack Recreation Center, 58 Depew Avenue, Nyack, New York.

The panel will include Louis Pupo, MD, pediatrician and Clinical Instructor of Pediatrics, Montefiore Medical Center, Albert Einstein College of Medicine and Jill Jones-Soderman, LCSW. Also presenting will be an attorney with practice focusing on the Family Courts.

“An Interview with Richard Gardner, MD” a short movie, will also be presented. The film will address the opportunities for inclusion of misinformation to be presented to the courts in family disputes and child custody cases. Dr. Gardner established a negative reputation for presenting erroneous information to the courts under the guise of being a credible medical professional.

The Foundation for the Child Victims of the Courts, LLC is organized to identify, educate, remediate the occurrence of civil rights violations which occur within the Family Court System as well as within the cottage industry which has grown up to serve the family court population involved with custody/best interest concerns. The presentation, planned as one of a series is directed at providing information and insight to Judges, court staff, professionals who work with the court system, the public and legislators, regarding the need for serious review of practices within the Family Court system.

“This is an important presentation for individuals and families who have experienced the complexity of dealing with the family courts, and an opportunity for those who serve the public within the court system. Divorce has become a public health crisis” stated Ms. Jones-Soderman. “The impact of the court experience can be catastrophic or curative. The legacy of the court experience has a ripple effect impacting family school and community . The legal system has a responsibility to the public that it serves, beyond the iron hand justice meted out under a veil of secrecy within the confines of a closed system.

THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY RETALIATES:

A child commits suicide rather than being returned to the abusive parent from whom Jill Jones-Soderman tried to protect him:

The Court and their Minions placed the child directly in Harm's Way – Suppressing Medical/Psychiatric Reports detailing abuse.

JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT

UNETHICAL/BIASED BEHAVIOR OF AN EVALUATOR

The Resources of the State Agencies combine to remove a Mandated Reporter who has uncovered Fraud/Judicial Misconduct/Abuse Of Power And Collusion between State Agencies to crush and Discredit An Honest Reporter of Child Torture and Domestic Violence.

An Evaluator who engaged in and continues to engage in Biased/Unethical Behavior through participating in multiple functions in the course of an Evaluation and then capitalizes on his knowledge – by treating one party of the family from whom he has just removed Custody – and that Party is not the Parent without Resources.

The New Jersey State Licensing Board has failed to protect a Licensee mandated to follow the Ethics of the Profession.

The Licensing Board has acted as a minion of those who abuse Discretion and Power by using the Resources of the State – The Attorney General's Office – The Office of Insurance Fraud - to attempt to concoct false charges to discredit a Mandated Reporter in the course of performing a responsibility within the scope of the Profession.

Patient Confidentiality is breached by the exceptions to HIPPA able to be called upon by the Licensing Board and Attorney General's Office demanding the Disclosure of multiple patient records.

HIPPA Exceptions – Violations of Patient Confidentiality

The Unabridged Complete Files of any patient who has ever filed insurance claims through an Insurance Company or through a Company that processes Insurance Claims; (Magellan) can be accessed through the demands of a Licensing Board or the Attorney General's Office over the protests of Clients and Therapists.

Violations of Patient Confidentiality and Privacy can be committed under cover of Law:

Even when the Therapist is not a Provider with any Insurance Company

Even when the Therapist does not accept payment from any Insurance Company

Even when the Therapist does not send bills to any Insurance Company

Insurance Companies normally send copies of bills paid – dates – amounts paid to the Patient, otherwise known as "Explanation of Benefits".

If a Therapist is paid: Notice of Dates, Amounts Allowed Paid to the Providers are sent to the Therapist when a Patient is paid for services provided by a Therapist.

The Violations of Civil Rights in Family Courts across the Country is wide spread and adversely affects the lives of children and adults equally.

Abuse of Power and Discretion, the lack of relevant education, the lack of appropriate supervision, the lack of availability of psychotherapy to casework staff who work with the family court public, and the lack of checks and balances built in to every other court in the judicial system are the foundation of corruption and incorrect critical decisions within the family court system.

The poor fit between the social sciences and the legal process adversely affects the just adjudication of cases seen in family courts and throughout the juvenile justice system.

Richard S. Mazaway, Esq. of Clifton, NJ, Ms. Jones-Soderman's New Jersey Attorney has been removed from her Legal Team for failure to pursue the multiple violation of her rights.

The Ascendance of Attorney's who represent Ms. Jones-Soderman's Personal and Professional interests are now in place and will be proceeding with action to confront the issues that her case exemplifies as to the abuse of Power and Discretion and Corruption within the Family Courts across the country.
